

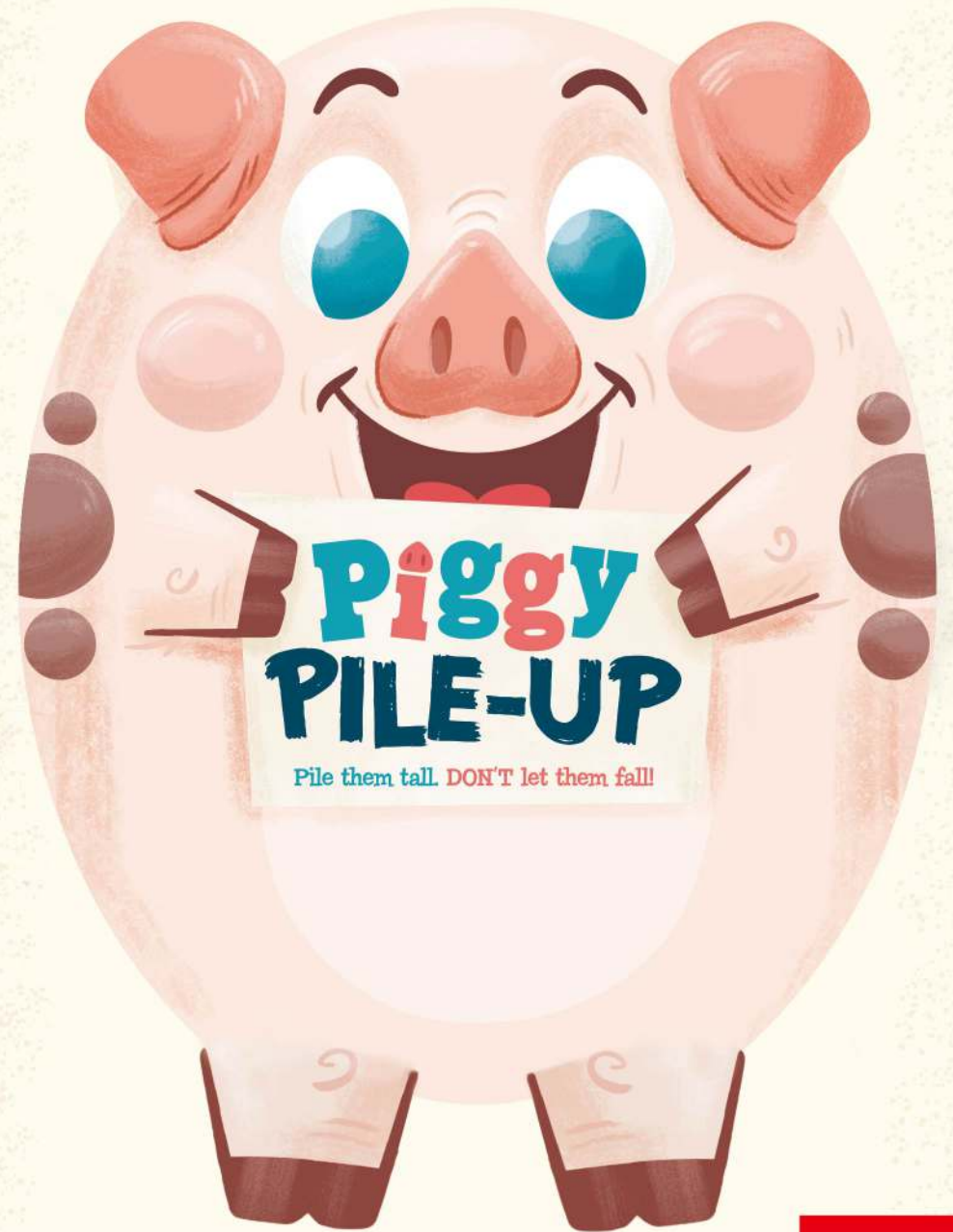
WINNING:

If you're the first player to place your last piggy piece on the piggy pile without any pieces falling, you win! Now do the piggy dance!



SOLO GAME:

It's not easy to place all 12 piggy pieces on the mud puddle. Can you do it? If so, you win!

Includes: 12 wooden piggy pieces, 1 mud puddle base, 1 drawstring storage bag and rules for two games.



Pile them tall.
DON'T let them fall!



OBJECT:

Be first to get rid of all your piggy pieces by carefully piling them without any pieces falling.

SET UP:

The game is easiest to play on a hard, flat surface. Place the mud puddle base in the center of the play area. With all the piggy pieces in the bag, take turns drawing piggy pieces, until all of them are drawn. All the players should have the same number of piggy pieces at the start of the game.

PLAY:

- 1:** The youngest player goes first. If that's you, place any one of your piggy pieces on the mud puddle base. To begin the game, pieces should be placed within the groove in the center of the base, not on the edges of the base.



don't place pigs on the edge of mud puddle

- 2:** Turns pass to the left. If on your turn, any piggy pieces fall off of the pile or off the mud puddle base, your turn ends. You must take any pieces that fell.
